PUBLIC ADVISORY NO. 17-2021

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS TO TRAVELERS FROM INDIA FROM 29 APRIL TO 14 MAY 2021

The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago wishes to inform the public that, pursuant to Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID) Resolution No. 112 Series of 2021 dated 27 April 2021, all travelers from India or those with travel history to India within the last fourteen (14) days preceding arrival shall be prohibited from entering the Philippines from 29 April to 14 May 2021.

Passengers already in transit from said country and all those who have been to the same within 14 days immediately preceding arrival, who will arrive before 0001H of 29 April 2021, shall not be subject to above restriction, but shall be required to undergo stricter quarantine and testing protocols (absolute facility-based 14-day quarantine period notwithstanding a negative Reverse Transcription – Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) result).
