PUBLIC ADVISORY NO. 28-2021

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS TO TRAVELERS FROM INDIA, PAKISTAN, NEPAL, SRI LANKA, BANGLADESH, OMAN, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES, INDONESIA, MALAYSIA AND THAILAND UNTIL 31 AUGUST 2021

The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago wishes to inform the public that, pursuant to Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID) Resolution No. 133 dated 12 August 2021, all travelers from India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Oman, United Arab Emirates, Indonesia, Malaysia and Thailand or those with travel history to said countries within fourteen (14) days preceding arrival, shall be prohibited from entering the Philippines until 31 August 2021.

Returning Filipinos under government and non-government repatriation programs are exempted from said restriction. Likewise exempted are passengers merely transiting through said countries who stayed in the airport the whole time (and were not cleared for entry by immigration authorities).
