NEWLY ELECTED ATTORNEY GENERAL OF ILLINOIS RECEIVES CONSUL GENERAL JAMORALIN

Springfield, IL - Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin, together with other members of the Chicago Consular Corps, witnessed the inauguration ceremonies of newly elected officials of the State of Illinois at the Bank of Springfield Center on Monday, January 14.

Governor JB Pritzker, Lt. Governor Juliana Stratton, Attorney General Kwame Raoul, Secretary of State Jesse White, Comptroller Susana Mendoza and Treasure Michael Frerichs were each sworn into office and delivered their inaugural addresses.

After the ceremonies, Attorney General Raoul hosted a reception at the Attorney General's Office where he received Consul General Jamoralin and the Chicago Consular Corps officials and other guests who came to greet and express their wishes for the 42nd Illinois Attorney General's success.

The son of Haitian immigrants, AG Raoul was a State Senator who replaced former President Barack Obama after being elected to the U.S. Senate in 2004. He succeeds former AG Lisa Madigan who served in the position for 16 years and made collaboration with the Chicago Consular Corps and the communities they represent a priority. **END**
