SBMA Chairperson & Administrator Wilma T. Eisma Calls on the Philippine Consulate General in Chicago

The Chairperson & Administrator of Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA), Atty. Wilma T. Eisma was received by Consul General Jamoralin at the Consulate on November 9, 2018. With the chairperson were SBMA Deputy Administrator Mr. Ronnie R. Yambao and Ms. Jennifer Pantig, SBMA Secretary.

The SBMA officials were in Chicago for a roundtable business meeting with private companies, members of the business community and organizations (e.g. Chambers of Commerce), and State officials to promote SBMA as an alternative investment area in the Asia Pacific region and develop port-to-port agreements.
