Chicago, 20 April 2018 – Former Supreme Commander of the Order of the Knights of Rizal Atty. Pablo S. Trillana III paid a courtesy call on Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin during a brief stay in Chicago on his way to St. Louis, Missouri.

Atty. Trillana delivered inspirational remarks to the Consulate-based Maynilad Chapter of the Knights of Rizal quoting immortal words of Dr. Jose P. Rizal. He spoke about the purpose of his trip to St. Louis, as a designated representative of KOR Supreme Commander and former Supreme Court Chief Justice Reynato Puno.

Consul General Jamoralin welcomed Atty. Trillana and lauded the efforts of the Knights of Rizal in trying to bring home and preserve memorabilia and artworks of Philippine national artists from abroad considered as national treasures for the edification of the Filipino people.
